Do This in Remembrance of Me

Different Names of the Holy Communion:

- Lord's Supper (1Cor. 11:20)
- Lord's Table (1Cor. 11:21)
- Breaking of Bread (Acts. 2:24; 20:7)
- Holy Communion (1Cor. 10:16)
- Eucharist (Eucharistio Gk. = Thanksgiving) (1Cor. 11:24)

The Significance of the Lord's Supper:

- 1. The Lord's Supper is instituted by Christ before his crucifixion (Mt. 26:26-29)
- 2. It is taught, promoted, and explained by the apostles (Acts 2:42; 20:7; 1Cor. 11:23-32).
- 3. It is practiced regularly by the early Church (Acts. 2:42; 20:27).
- 4. The Lord's Table is set only for believers (saved and baptized) (Acts. 2:41-42)).
- 5. The meaning of the Lord's Supper is primarily summed in the commandment of Christ, "Do this in remembrance of me" and the "New Covenant" he made with us in his shed blood (1Cor. 11:24-26).
- 6. The Lord's Supper centered in the partaking of the bread and the cup is symbolically the communion or partaking of the body and blood of Christ (1Cor. 10:16-17).
- 7. The Lord's Supper makes possible the participants to have both vertical and horizontal fellowship (1 Cor. 10:16-17).
- 8. The oneness of the body of Christ is made visible in the partaking of the same bread (1Cor. 10:17)
- 9. The observance of the ordinance of the Lord's Supper is a time of self-examination and Self judgment for the participants (iCor. 11:27-28).
- 10. The failure to acknowledge the significance of the Lord's Supper participate "in an unworthy manner" - can bring judgment - physical weakness, sickness, even death upon those who are involved (1Cor. 11:27-29).

The Lord's Supper leads its participant a backward look to the Crucified Christ, a upward look to the ascended Christ, and a forward look to the coming Christ. Is the Lord's Supper real to you?
